
## EXCHANGE OF BEST PRACTICES

Partners shared the collection of case studies and proposals that after LTT will be tested, compared and analyzed with the projects already carried out. The best practices will be collected in the Booklet that will remain available even after the project, and will be a sustainable tool in the long term available to all users who want to use it. It will be available and freely downloadable from the project website and from the consortium sites.



## ABOUT THE PROJECT

The main aim of the project is to introduce experimental prevention programs in different territories with the active involvement of young people using a methodology that combines the cognitive affective and relational elements that promote the non-formal education method. The participants will thought that the use of drugs is an "inadequate behavior, to be avoided as it puts at risk their own and the other's health, the psychic and social integrity as a whole" and transmit them a "disvalue and not a plus value".



## THE BOOKLET

Main result of the project will be the selection and construction of a drug prevention intervention model using a Non-Formal methodology. The Booklet will collect and illustrate in a reasoned manner the set of best practices and will at the same time be a "showcase", freely and easily consulted by a relatively large audience of subjects involved in different ways in the planning or implementation of interventions concerning the drug prevention, especially for those at risk.
